From St. Louis or Springfield

1. Take Interstate 44 to exit 186.
2. If traveling West on 44, turn left onto Highway 63/Bishop Ave. at the top of the ramp. If traveling East, turn right onto Highway 63/Bishop Ave.
3. Turn left onto Pine Street.
4. Turn right onto 16th Street. Parking is available in Lot L, across from Emerson Electric Company Hall.
5. Butler-Carlton Civil Engineering can be reached by crossing 16th Street on foot, traveling through the breezeway of Emerson Electric Company Hall, and entering Civil Engineering, on the left. If you reach the Physics Building, you have travelled too far.
